### Phonetic Alphabets

### ■ Listen to a lecture given in a marine biology class

As you all know, it is impossible for humans to breathe underwater without some kind of artificial assistance like oxygen tanks. How is it, then, that fish can “breathe” underwater? The answer is a beautifully simple structure known as the gill. Gills are usually located on both sides of a fish's body and are commonly covered by a flap of skin called the gill cover. Most fish have four rows of gills on each side of their head. In front of the gills, in the fish's mouth, there is a structure called a gill raker. The purpose of the gill raker is to prevent the gills from getting clogged with debris.

But how exactly does a fish use its gills to breathe? Well, they don't breathe in the same way that humans do, taking air in and out of their lungs. Instead, fish make use of oxygen that is dissolved in the water. You see, the gill tissue is composed of a very thin, blood enriched membrane that allows oxygen to be absorbed into the fish's body at the gill and then circulated throughout the rest of the body.

In addition to gills, some fish, like the mudfish, also have a very primitive lung called a “swim bladder.” Because mudfish live in water that is stagnant, or lacking in oxygen, they can sometimes be seen coming to the surface of a pond to grab a breath of fresh air, just like humans do when they're swimming.
